

NINA GREGORI (short CV)

Ms Nina Gregori is working at the Ministry of the Interior of Republic of Slovenia since 1996 and she is Director-General (or Deputy Director-General) responsible for the area of asylum, migration, integration, internal administrative affairs and naturalization since 2008.

She has been actively involved in the preparation of Slovenian positions for the dossiers in the area of migration, asylum, Schengen and visas for the relevant working bodies of the European Union since 1999. During the Slovenian Presidency of the Council of EU in 2008 she has chaired SCIFA (Strategic Committee on Immigration, Frontiers and Asylum) in which she is still Slovenian national delegate. Ms Gregori has participated in more than 50 Justice and Home Affairs Ministerial meetings and in European Union Councils as a member of Slovenian delegation.

Ms Gregori has participated in over 30 Inter-ministerial working groups for the preparation of the legislation in the field of migration, asylum, naturalization and registration of population, ID documents, weapons, political parties and data protection and in 2009 took over the chairing of the Inter-ministerial Working Group for the preparation of measures for the implementation of the migration policy. She also led the Inter-ministerial Working Group to address the issue of so called erased people in the ECHR pilot judgement procedure which was concluded with issuance of positive Final Resolution and ECHR decision in favour of Republic of Slovenia.

Ms Gregori is a member of Management Board of EASO (European Asylum Support Office) and long lasting national delegate in the Expert Working Group Migration at OECD. As a member of the Interdepartmental Commission on Human Rights Ms Gregori is a leader or permanent member of various delegations of the Republic of Slovenia in procedures and instruments of the United Nations and the Council of Europe.

Ms Gregori speaks English, Croatian and Serbian fluently and can actively communicate in Italian and German language. She is married and has two children.
